



Stable Rules

The following list of rules is to be read and followed. Any boarder who fails to comply with any of the rules on this list may be asked to leave the premises at the sole discretion of the management.

1. **No smoking** on the premises!
2. **No Dogs**
3. **No drinking** of alcoholic beverages allowed on the property
4. **No unattended children!** Children can get injured around horses. Parents are responsible for all under 18 (minor) children.
5. **In case of an emergency dial 911 address of Kel-j-Do is:**
Corner of Range Road 240 and Township 510 north east of Beaumont.
Across from Coloniale Golf Course
6. **Proper safety equipment must be worn while** – i.e. Boots. Do not ride without proper safety equipment. Kel-j-Do will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or deaths. Protect yourself when riding, lunging and working around horses. The appropriate attire for riding includes: Helmet, Riding Boots. Kel- J-Do Stables liability insurance insists that proper safety equipment be used for riding at all times. A Helmet is mandatory for anyone under 18 working around or riding horses
7. **Tack room shall be kept clean and neat.** Keep the area clean of tack, brushes, halters, hoof pickings, or manure. If you or your horse put it there, pick it up! All grooming equipment shall be put away in your designated tack cubby. It is suggested that all equipment be clearly marked with owner's name.
8. **Tacking Up stall areas outside shall be kept clean.** Be considerate, if your horse(s) make a mess, clean it up immediately. Please clean up after your horse when riding in the sand and green jumping ring,
9. **No Jumping without a coach.**
10. **If you turned on a light, turn it off** when you are finished using that area.
11. **In case of equine injury, Please Notify Tom 780-929-6680 or Donna 780-238-1955**
12. **Always mount and dismount outside** and do a last minute safety check before doing so.
13. **No abusive treatment toward horses will be tolerated** and shall result in the dismissal of the boarder.
14. **Gates to paddocks should be closed at all times,** except while passing through.

- 15. No visitors are allowed in the pasture.** Boarders may enter the pasture to retrieve ONLY the owner's equine. Owners may not handle any equine other than their own or an animal they have leased.
- 16. Do not ride on properties not designated as allowed riding areas.** The stable will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or death occurring because a rider failed to stay on proper trails, fields or roads. The stable will not be responsible for any fines and/or jail terms for trespassing on posted or non-posted properties.
- 17. No running, yelling or loud music around the horses** in the Tack Room or courtyard. The stable cannot be responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with scaring or spooking an equine due to inappropriate behaviour.
- 18. No bicycles or motorized vehicles.**
- 19. Do not tie your horse with your reins.** All horses are to be tied in the tacking stalls outside with a lead rope while wearing a serviceable halter. The stable will not be responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with tying your horse with the reins, or bailing twine or any other inappropriate equipment. Do not leave your horses unattended
- 20. Always check your tack before riding.** The stable will not be responsible for the quality of repair of your tack and will not be held responsible for any injury, accident and/or death associated with using tack in ill repair.
- 21. All injuries, accidents and damages must be immediately brought to our attention.** Any unreported incidents will be the responsibility of the boarder or leaser. All equine activity that results in accident, injury or death shall not be held at fault of Kel- J-Do Stables or its owners.
- 22. Stable is open from 8:00 am to 9:00 pm (summer only).** Boarders are permitted to ride only in the stated hours unless otherwise arranged. Boarders must make appointments to visit their horses after hours.
- 23. In case of an emergency concerning the boarder's horse, a vet should be called at the boarder's expense in their absence.**
- 24. If you bring a Guest, make sure the guest reads the stable rules.** If riding must sign the waiver located in the office.
- 25. Please check for notices regarding vet, farrier,** etc. It is up to all boarders to read notices which apply to their horse(s). Vet/Farrier farm calls shall be divided between those needing the service. The more people we schedule together, the cheaper it will be for the call. If you are unable to be here for your appointment we will arrange one for you.
- 26. Regular de-worming/ vaccinations of all horses are required.** Notices will be posted.
- 27. There shall be a Sign In/Out & Trail Riding Form posted.** When you leave to go riding, this must have been filled out. If your horse comes back without you, or you don't come back before dark, we want to know when/where to go look for you. Alternatively let someone know where you are going and when you will be back, for your safety!
- 28. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.**
